

Description

A beautiful route through Derbyshire, taking in some high country. You will visit 12 churches on the route, receiving a pilgrim stamp & Bible verse at each for your pilgrim 'credencial' (provided). There is time to pray at each stop & along the way, as well as enjoying God's creation. Spreading the pilgrimage across the year enables us to enjoy the different seasons. It also means we save money by not needing accommodation — and, trust me on this, it is a lot easier than walking on three successive days with a full pack!

This route is shorter than the Peak Pilgrimage but more challenging, with big ascents & descents. So you need a reasonable level of fitness; to be able to walk 10+ miles at around 2 mph. Good boots & walking equipment are essential too. You will receive full information about travel, route, public toilets & a weather update for each stage.

Practicalities for 2025

We can take a group of 6-10 people. I feel the mix of churches is important; so, no more than two from any one parish. If you want to bring a parish group, you can buy the guide & lead it yourselves! It's not difficult & I would be glad to give advice.
