Stage 1: Ilam to Hartington. 9.5 miles

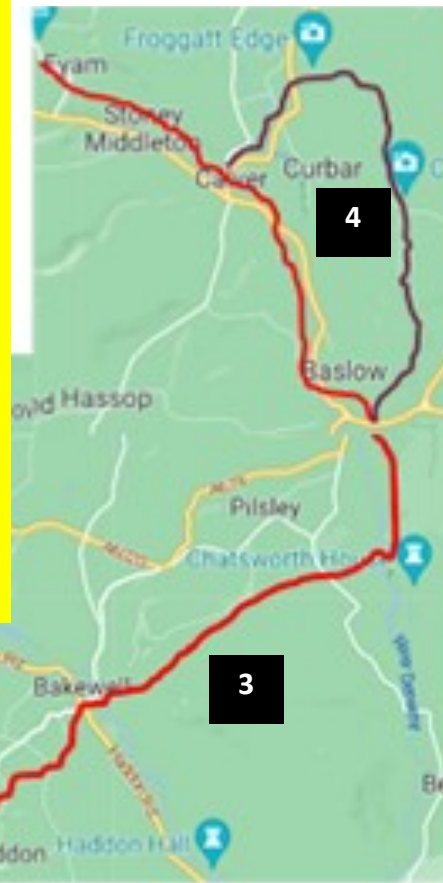
Stage 2: Hartington to Monyash. 9 miles

### Description

A beautiful route through Derbyshire, taking in Dove Dale & Lathkilldale, passing the magnificent Chatsworth House & following Curbar Edge. You will visit 12 churches on the route, receiving a pilgrim stamp & Bible verse at each for your pilgrim 'credencial' (provided). There is time to pray at each stop & along the way, as well as enjoying God's creation. Spreading the pilgrimage across the year enables us to enjoy the different seasons. It also means we save money by not needing accommodation — and, trust me on this, it is a lot easier than walking on four successive days with a full pack!

You will need a reasonable level of fitness; to be able to walk 10+ miles at around 2 mph. There are some fairly steep climbs & rough sections, so good boots & walking equipment are needed. You will receive full information about travel, route, public toilets & a weather update for each stage.

### Practicalities for 2025

We have taken groups of 6-10 people, all from different churches. It's harder to keep a big group moving. The mix of churches is important. So, we'd like to keep it to no more than two from any one parish. If you want to bring a parish group, you can buy the guide & lead it yourselves! It's not difficult & I would be glad to give advice.
